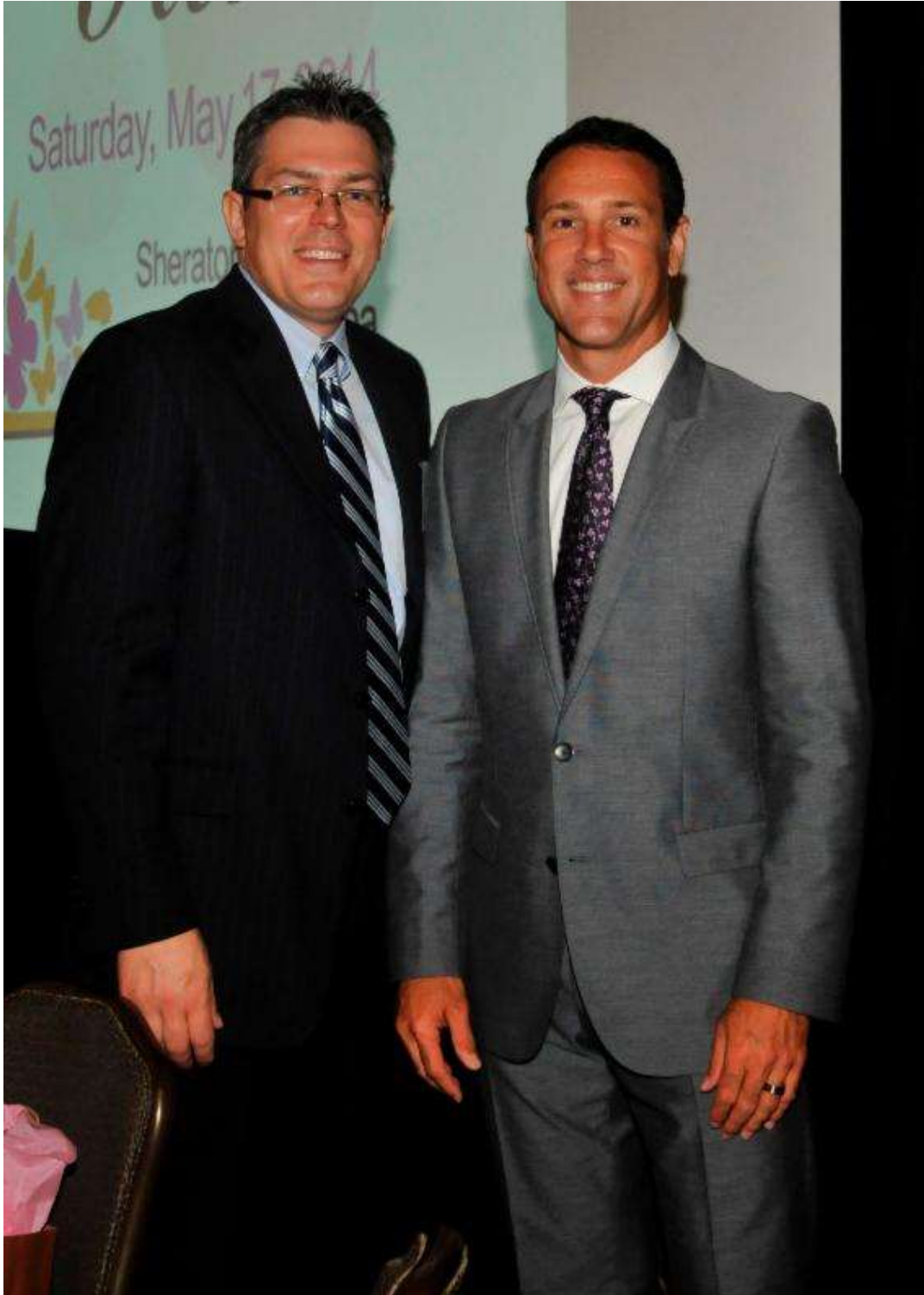

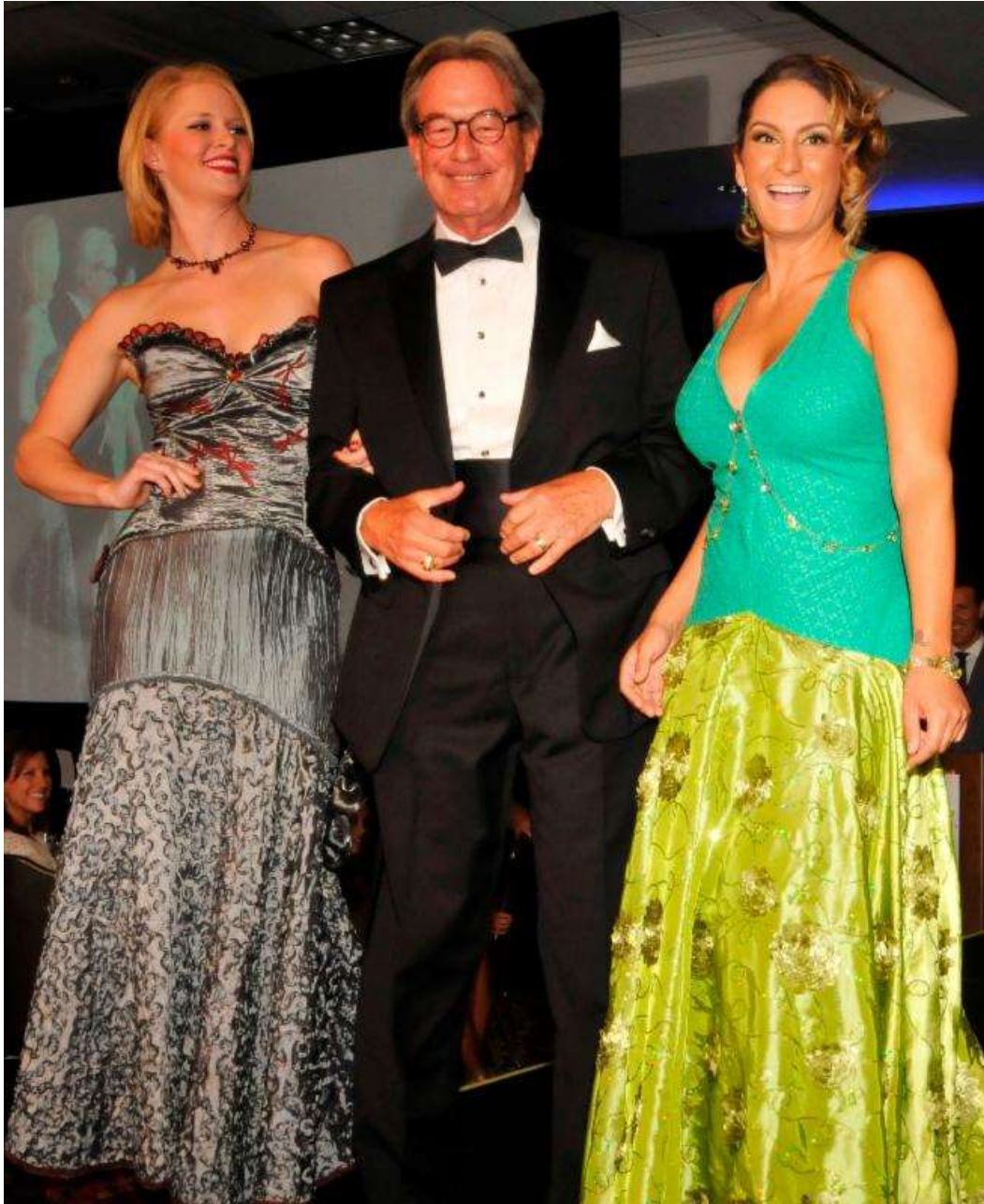

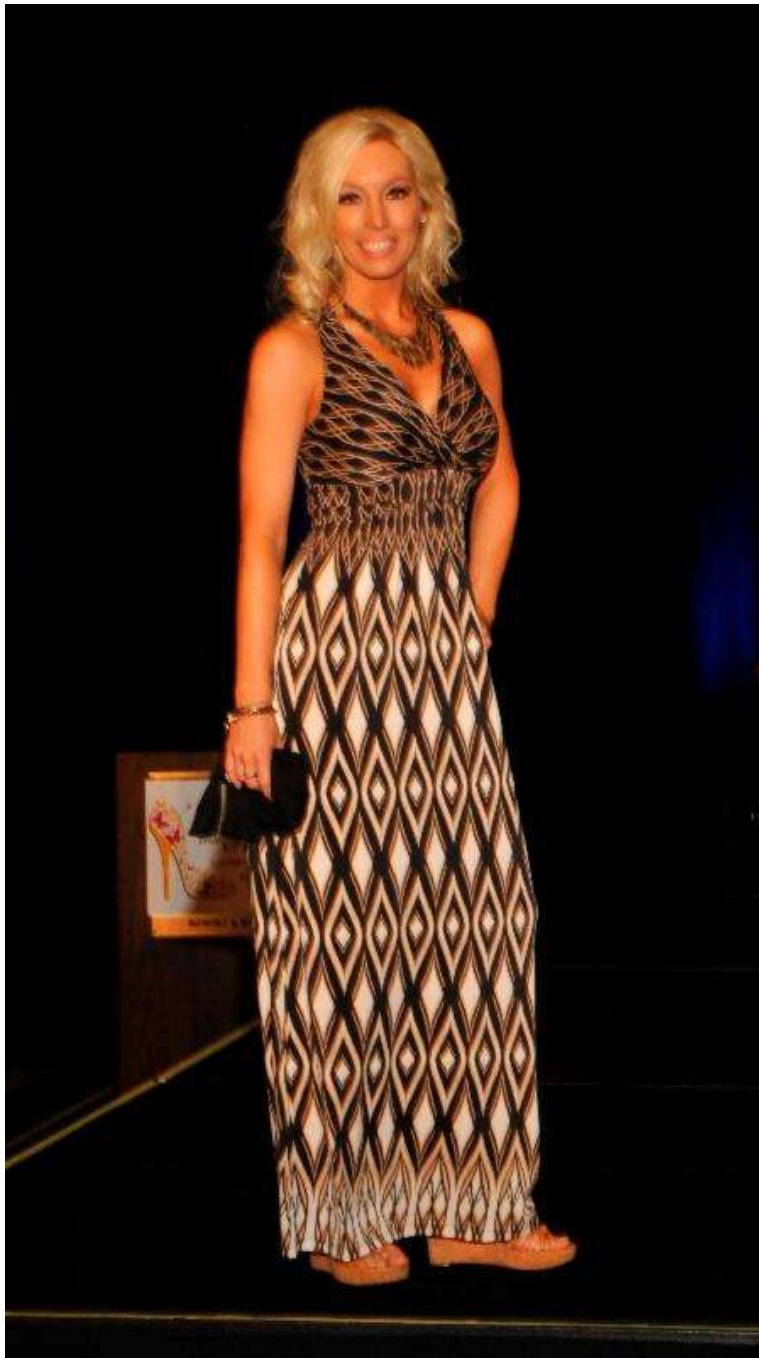

## **TRI-CITY MEDICAL CENTER RECOGNIZED WITH QUALITY ACHIEVEMENT AWARD FOR HEART FAILURE CARE**

*Tri-City Medical Center is the only medical center in San Diego County, and one of only 12 in the nation to receive gold plus awards in both heart failure and stroke care.*



Tri-City Medical Center has received the Get With The Guidelines - Heart Failure Gold-Plus Quality Achievement Award for implementing specific quality improvement measures outlined by the American Heart Association/American College of Cardiology Foundation secondary prevention guidelines for heart failure patients.

The medical center was the only one in San Diego to receive Quality Achievement Award recognition in both heart failure and stroke care.

Get With The Guidelines - Heart Failure is a quality improvement program that helps hospital teams provide the most up-to-date, research-based guidelines with the goal of speeding recovery and reducing hospital readmission for heart failure patients.

Tri-City Medical Center earned the award by meeting specific quality achievement measures for the diagnosis and treatment of heart failure patients at a set level for a designated period. These measures include proper use of medications and aggressive risk-reduction therapies such as cholesterol-lowering drugs, beta blockers, ACE inhibitors, aspirin, diuretics and anticoagulants while patients are in the hospital. Before patients are discharged, they also receive education on managing their heart failure and overall health, as well as referrals for cardiac rehabilitation.

Congratulations to Tri-City Medical Center and all the dedicated employees who made this award possible.

## TRI-CITY MEDICAL CENTER RECOGNIZED FOR EXCELLENCE IN CANCER



Tri-City Medical Center was recently recognized with the CoC Outstanding Achievement Award. Established in 2004, the Commission on Cancer (CoC) Outstanding Achievement Award (OAA) is designed to recognize cancer programs that strive for excellence in providing quality care to cancer patients. A facility receives the OAA following an onsite evaluation by a physician surveyor during which the facility demonstrates a commendation level of compliance with seven standards that represent the full scope of the cancer program and receives a compliance rating for the remaining 27 standards.

The seven standards that form the basis of the OAA criteria are drawn from the following five areas of program activity:

- Cancer committee leadership



- Cancer conferences
- Clinical management
- Quality improvement

OAA recipients represent community-based facilities, academic hospitals, NCI-designated Comprehensive Cancer Centers, Veterans Administration hospitals, integrated networks, pediatric hospitals, and freestanding cancer centers.

## CORPORATE COUNCIL IS ALIVE AND THRIVING



The Corporate Council is a group of community and business leaders who work together to support Tri-City Medical Center. Under the new leadership of Phil Soule, Principal for the Cuningham Group, the Corporate Council held its first meeting of the year on June 9. The Corporate Council, now in its tenth year, raises money for the hospital through corporate memberships and sponsoring events. Plans are already underway for a 2015 Golf Tournament. Through the years, the Council has raised more than \$534,000 to support projects at Tri-City Medical Center. At the June 9th meeting the members approved a \$110,000 donation to Tri-City Medical Center, which will be used to help construct a new Psychiatric Crisis Stabilization Unit - the first of its kind for North San Diego County.

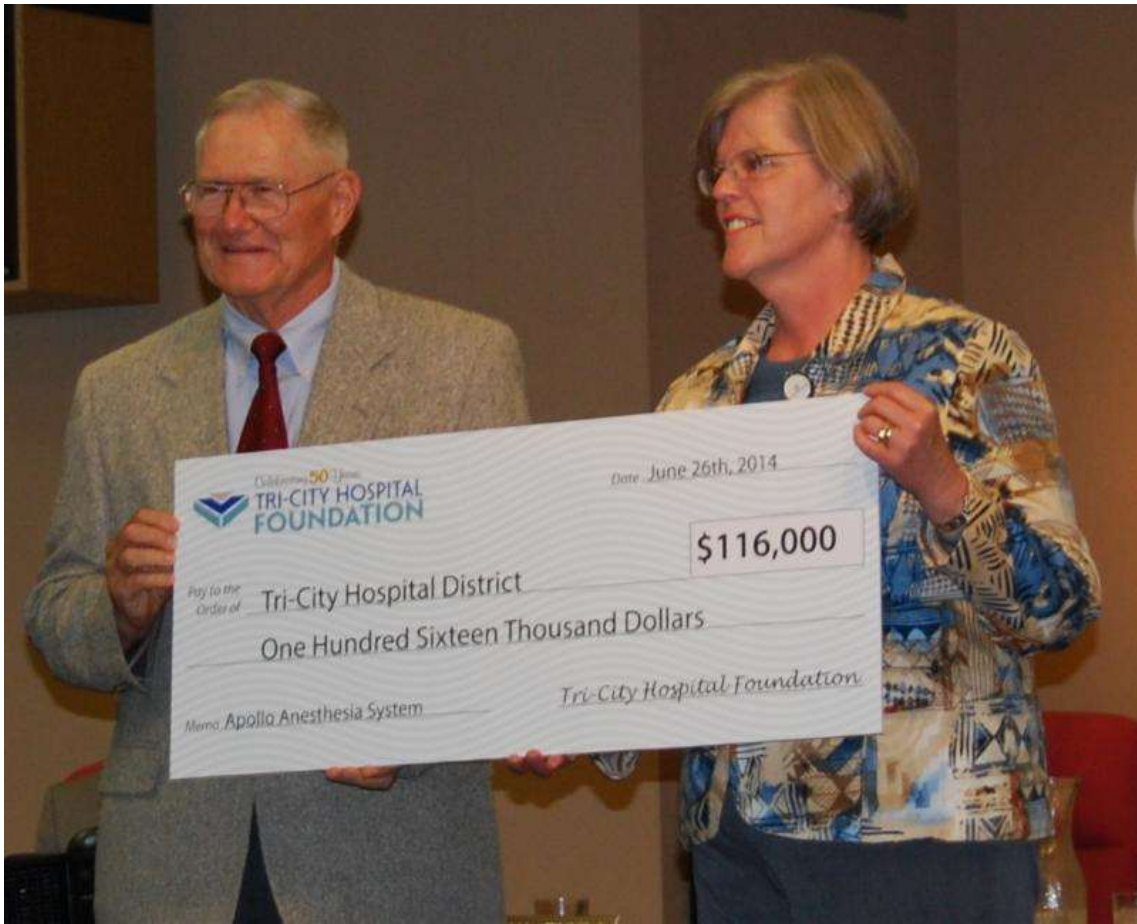
